-The Committee Chair has written a	
consult document that will be provided	
to the proponents and SCC prior to	
review at the SCC meeting.	
-The Committee notes that Graduate	
students in a related graduate program	
expressed a concern that the use of	
existing courses (that are part of the	
MSN) for the new MHLPCE, could impact	
their ability to enroll in these courses.	
This may or may not be a concern; this is	
a budget and resource issue. The	
Committee would like to make the	
proponents aware of this issue and ask if	
they see this as a potential problem	
moving forward.	
-The Committee asks the proponents to	
review the proposal for the consistent	
use of effective session dates. If you are	
looking to offer this program in January	
2017 the proper effective session date	

would be 2016 W.

- The Committee recommends the proponents complete program consults with SPPH, MEDI, and EDUC, CHES (Centre for Health Education and Scholarship) within the faculty of MEDI.
- -The table of contents does not match the document. See 2.9 not existing in the table of contents, but existing later in the document. Also section 2.8.4 comes after 2.9.
- -The Committee asks that the proposal be reviewed for consistency and appropriate section headings – as tied to the table of contents.
- -The Committee raised concerns over the programs distribution of work per term 12 credits in term 1, 7.5 credits in term 2, 10.5 credits in term 3. The Committee encourages the proponents to more evenly distribute course work throughout the program.
- -Proposal page 35 The proposal makes reference to fieldwork and co-op education experiences, but no details are provided. It is not clear to the Committee if these are really intended to be part of the program.
- -The Committee feels that consultations with clinical practice partner organizations in addition to Vancouver Coastal Health should be considered.
- -The Committee would like the proponents to know that BCIT has a certificate program in Health Care Management (undergraduate certificate) that is very well subscribed. There is no mention of this in the proposal.
- -Please ensure the NURS 540/504 changes have all been made.
- -The Committee notes that the budgetary impact form is still awaiting submission.

#### NURS 531 (3)

- -The Committee recommends providing a more detailed section related to assessment and grading prior to delivering this course to students.
- -The inclusion of a table that breaks

down the assignments and their grades is encouraged.
-The Committee encourages the proponents to refine the learning objectives section to ensure that each objective is a clearly defined outcome.

-The Committee recommends that appropriate percentage breakdown of grades be included in the assessment section of the syllabi.

-The Committee notes some confusion in the course schedule as week 13 does not appear to be necessary.
