MECH 559 (1-2) d – Create new course

- Committee felt this was an interesting idea and is supportive in principle, but more work must be done to focus the course and provide structure for students.
- Learning objectives are very broad and overly ambitious for a single course of 1 to 2 credits.
- Given the flexibility and choice built into the course, it is unclear how the set of course learning objectives will be met by all students. Seems that the objectives on which an individual student might progress would be highly dependent upon the specific activities in which they opted to participate. Could proponents identify a smaller set of measureable learning objectives they expect all students to meet through this course and then a larger set that students might meet depending on the learning activities selected?
- It would be helpful for this committee and for students taking the course if proponents could link each of the learning activities to specific learning outcomes or objectives, perhaps in a grid or table. Students could then potentially identify learning outcomes important to them and select activities appropriate to their personal goals.

- Syllabus fails to provide connections between activities, assessments, and outcomes. What criteria will be used to grade the logbook and essay? How are students expected to demonstrate progress or competence with respect to the course learning outcomes?
- What is the role of the instructor in this course?
- Will students select a credit value for the course at the time of registration or are they free to decide that at a later time?
- The external workshops and activities on which this course is based are likely to shift dramatically over time. How will this be addressed?
- Perhaps we could provide a sample (PPGA 510 Professional Practice in Public Policy and Global Affairs might be appropriate).
