- This is the second new program proposal put forward by GCC that was held by the SCC due to issues around the Indigenous Strategic Plan. Members asked that the Indigenous Strategic Plan be added to a future GCC agenda for discussion. There was a suggestion that the committee aim to develop a set of common questions they can ask when reviewing new program proposals. Copies of the previously held proposals with the revisions highlighted were also requested.

## Faculty of Arts Submitted by Catherine Rawn / Heidi May

### THFL 599 (3-6) d – Create new course

- Committee encourages the course instructor(s) to think through the intended
  outcomes of the course and to develop a template agreement to be completed jointly
  by the student and instructor prior to the start of each student's project. This should
  include an appropriate credit value for the project and mutually agreed upon projectspecific learning outcomes and methods of assessment. Members encourage allowing
  some room for renegotiation of this mutual understanding as the project unfolds.
- Rationale mentions creating "catchall" 1 credit and 2 credit versions. Heidi clarified that these will be bundled to create course versions of at least 3 credits. If that's the case, the proposed credit value will work, but the proponents should be aware that scheduling individual 1 or 2 credit versions will not be possible with the proposed 3-6 credit value for the course.
